# BIBLICAL HEALING

In our last issue, we cover the issue on how our father's sins have an adverse impact on our life. In this issue, we shall touch on how our father's sins brought along with them curses. A curse is a penalty that has to be paid from the breaking of a law. Just as the Government imposed a fine on us for violating the law and will pursue us till we pay the fine in full, God's law is the same. It would continue to search out the family line until the full penalty is paid. The difference is that if we disobey God's law the penalty can never be paid in full without the cross. Only by the blood of Jesus Christ can our sins and penalty be paid to stop the curse. Kenneth Copeland defines a **curse as an empowerment to fail and a blessing an empowerment to succeed.**

Businessmen who experience losses may have ancestors who had owned slaves and the latter may have put a curse on the family. I would also say the same with business partners when the partnership fails. I know of a woman who keeps cursing her brother that the business he and his wife are operating will fail and because they do not know God they failed. Even after knowing God they started another business, they also failed because they did not work out with God on the healing process for the curses and the sins of their forefathers as well as themselves, including the curses of the man's sister.

People always ask me why good parents beget handicapped children or down syndrome children. Myths point this to the result of the father having sexual relationship on the night they were intoxicated. But one case study shows that a family whose middle child was handicapped had two ancestors who had witnessed the murder of a little boy. They had been party to the crime by remaining silent. Being involved in the crime had opened the door for physical curses to come on their descendants.

## **Sources of curse:**

- (a) From God**
- (b) From your desire to bring distress and failure into a person's life**
- (c) Cursing of oneself**

## **From God**

It is very clear in Genesis 3 that God cursed the land after the fall of Adam instigated by Eve. Other curses are seen in the flood and in Moses' pronouncements against Egypt. Throughout the Old Testaments you would have read God's pronouncement of curses for disobedience of His law and commandments. Although the curse was on the Israelites, it applies to us for disobedience as well. When you plant a seed of disobedience you reap a harvest of judgement.

Let us look at David's line of ancestors that have caused him to enter into the sins of adultery,

deception, conspiracy and murder.

David's grandmother was Ruth, a Moabite and his great grandmother was Rahab, a Canaanite, the keeper of the inn in Jericho. These were two heathen nations known for their idolatry and sexual sins that were grafted into the Israelite line preceding David within four generations.

In Genesis 38, Judah had sexual relations with his daughter-in-law Tamar thinking she was a temple prostitute. She was said to be an Israelite. Ignorance is no excuse and definitely not a bliss. Deception, fornication and lying were all involved in this sin and perhaps occult/idol worship. Judah's father Jacob (Israel) had a tendency towards deceit, lying, cursing, cheating etc. All these were evident before his encounter with the angel. Rebekah his mother entered into deception with Jacob even calling for the resulting curse to be upon herself. His wife, Rachel stole her father's household gods and lied about them resulting in Jacob's unintentional cursing of her and her early death. Both Abraham and Isaac were guilty of lying saying that their wives were their sisters. For Abraham, it was half truth since his wife was his half sister.

David did not have a pure family line if you trace the above history. We are uncertain about his ten nearest ancestors except for Boaz who was a righteous man. Hence even though David had a heart after God, David chose to enter into the sins of his fathers in his sin with Bathsheba.

David is a reminder to us to be on guard. We must not assume that we will not fall. How many pastors have fallen already! We may be powerfully used by God but this does not mean that Satan will not tempt us to fall. He always lies in wait ready to pounce at us. Be always on the alert for the enemy's attack. We need to stop the counterattack before it begins.

We are not to take responsibility of our ancestors' sins. But we are required to confess our father's iniquity. God expects us to take responsibility of our own iniquity, to repent and to be humbled. When we do this, God will remember His covenant. In other words, He will fulfill His promises of forgiveness and cleansing – to us and to the land.

Daniel, Nehemiah and Ezra all prayed and confessed the sins of their forefathers for themselves and their people. It was not necessary to ask for forgiveness for their forefathers since they are not required to take responsibility of their sins. Daniel confessed his and their sins. He confessed to God that He was right and they were wrong. He also agreed with God that He was right to bring the curses upon them. Then he called for God's righteousness and mercy and asked Him to restore the situation. Throughout scriptures, God always relent when we confess our sins and ask Him for forgiveness.

**Neh 9:3** Nehemiah followed the same pattern as Lev 26:40. They confessed their sins and the iniquities of their fathers before beginning their corporate prayer. Ezra 9 follows the same pattern. Repentance breaks the power of demonic strongholds over geographical areas and revival will come forth. Repentance of the sins of our fathers will bring us freedom. Now that we are under grace, we can appropriate His work on the cross by faith.

Let us face reality. We always have the ego that we are very righteous. In actual fact, no one can keep God's law. The Israelites could not too. Our disobedience in breaking the law results in curses coming upon us. For instance we are to submit to authorities. But no one can actually submit to authorities and they have their reasons for non-submission. This results in going against God's law and so the curse comes upon them. But thank God Jesus is our substitute if we will receive Him as such by faith. If we repent, He redeemed us. (Ro 13:1)

### **How can we bring freedom to our children?**

If you are delivered before the children are born, the new infant/s is under the new family line, one rooted in the family of God. Young children from infants to four to five years can be ministered whilst they are asleep. Then, through prayer, you can move into a position of authority as both parent and intercessor. You will be able to cast out related demons.

For older children they can only acquire freedom through ministry.

## DIY Ministry steps

- 1. Confess:** Receiver can confess the sins of his father and his own sins
- 2. Forgiveness:** Have him forgive his ancestors and parents who are still alive for any and all sins that they have committed that have affected his life. Have him forgive them for specific sins as appropriate.
- 3. Forgive:** He must forgive every living person who has spoken word curses against him and/or his ancestors
- 4. Repent:** Have him ask God for forgiveness for entering into the sins of his fathers and for yielding to the curses affecting him. Have him to choose to turn away from any and all sins of the fathers as well as from his own personal sins.
- 5. Forgive:** Have him forgive himself for his own personal sins for self curses and for carrying guilt, shame and self hatred.
- 6. Receive:** Speak forgiveness and pray for cleansing
- 7. Renounce:** Have the receiver renounce any more involvement or putting up with the sins and curses.
- 8. Appropriate:** Appropriate and apply the power of the cross and the shed blood of Christ to stop all judgements and curses.

I pray that as you go through all these newsletters, your spiritual eyes will be opened. To God be the glory!
