## WORD FOR THE WEEK

*"The vision of the evenings and mornings that has been given you is true, but seal up the vision, for it concerns the distant future." (Dan 8:26)*

**Beloved,**

There have been testimonies of healing miracles last week. What about you? Have you been praying for the sick this week? We will soon be starting **Elijah Challenge Healing Service** on every Saturday which will be a Bilingual Service which will be focused on Healing and Evangelism.

We need to build a Church that will last.

It must first start with assembling together. If the key Leaders do not commit to Ministry, how do we expect the visitors to give us commitment? If we are to draw in visitors to become our members, then there must be commitment from the Leaders for the Ministry especially the Prayer Ministry on every Wednesday. You cannot lead a Ministry without committing to Prayer Ministry on Wednesday.

Acts 2:46 **"and they continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart."**

Covenant Relationships require quantity and quality time both of which were given willingly. A Church **is not** a place to go to on every Sunday morning to fulfill a religious duty. It was their community. It involved all aspects of life everyday. The disciples dedicated their time to a life of togetherness. This means they were all together at the same time and in the same place. The Greek word church is translated as **ekklesia**. It comes from two words: **ek** which means out of and **klesis** which means a calling. It refers to any group of people called to an assembly. It does not refer to a building but to a particular group of people assembled for a particular purpose. It is the assembly of

the saints.

We know that God Himself became man to relate and minister to the sons of men. Apostle Paul said in 1 Cor 9:22 **"I have become all things to all men that I might by all means save some."**

The New Testament Church gathered together in **one accord** - meaning with **one mind, one spirit or one passion**. The same expression appears twelve times in the New Testament, eleven in the book of Acts. Whether it was to pray, to discuss problems or to respond to preaching, the New Testament Church came together with one accord. Jesus taught that a house divided against itself cannot stand (Mt 12:25). To last, a house must have **unity**. The church is a unified organism, a living harmonious whole. God designed it to function with one mind (Ro 12:16, Phil 2:2).

We thank God for the unity of the spirit in recent months and we can see the Church gradually growing. May we continue to maintain this unity of the spirit so that the Church can blossom. God displayed His power in unified assemblies of His people at the Tabernacle of Moses (Ex 40:2, 34).

The Temple of Solomon: **"Indeed it came to pass, when the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the Lord, and when they lifted up their voices ... the house was filled with a cloud, so that the priests could not continue ministering because of the cloud; for the Glory of the Lord filled the house of God"** (2 Chron 5:13-14).

The Day of Pentecost: **"Now when the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord, in one place....."** (Acts 2:1-4).

Christians know that they are dwelling in unity when they are sensitive to their

brother's and sister's needs. If individuals cannot feel the hurts of the wounded or rejoice in the successes of others in a local Church, they lack unity.

Humility lays the ground work for unity. Pride separates people. The Apostolic Church certainly had disagreements but true unity means the saints work it out. The beloved brothers and sisters are committed to working through problems without becoming divided.

Each member has a unique, individual function and significance. At the same time, each member's role relates to the purpose of the entire body. (1 Cor 12:11-12). No single member of the body is more important than another. Each member gains its significance by belonging to the whole. When each member has equal respect and care for the others, unity is maintained (1 Cor 12:14-18).

God desires that different Ministries function together at the same time. Diverse needs among the sheep require diverse shepherding skills. It is the only way Pastoral Leadership can hope to meet all the needs. God's plan calls for unity of fellowship among diverse Ministers and members; that approach brings abundant life and health to the house of God. The Church needs the ministry of pastors, and it also needs the ministry of the prophets, the evangelists, some good teachers, administrators, fatherly apostles, helpers and others. Diverse Ministries give it strength. All members of Christ's body work together to perform a wide range of tasks. The local Church is a lot healthier and more effective when differing Ministries are allowed to exist side by side.
