WORD FOR THE WEEK

"From the rising of the sun to its going down
The Lord's name is to be praised." (Ps 113:3)

Beloved,

Easter is now over and we are preparing for Mother's Day. We praise God for a good discussion at our last **Elijah Challenge** meeting last week which we have launched. We have indeed decided to set aside each Saturday afternoon as **Healing Service**. It has been awesome last week and we saw God's powerful Healing coming down us mightly.

As I wait upon God for the coming Saturday Service, I could feel the strong anointing of the Lord upon me and I knew that God was preparing us for greater things to come. One thing the Lord is asking of us is to clear doubts from our spirit and to expect a miracle. Until His Glory comes upon us and we allow the invisible to come forward to lay down our crown of what we know, we will never be able to see the miracles of God manifesting in our Services. As God brought me back into reflection of how He used me in Sri Lanka more than 15 years ago in miracle Healing, I realized the difference. Those times, I was a very young Christian in the Lord. I move about by faith to pray for people expecting a miracle and not allowing the self destructive talk of 'would God heal such an infirmity?'

We need to let the people see God ministering instead of us and then the people will experience miracles. All miracles come from Him and Glory is reserved only for Him. We are not to look at titles or the power God has given to us. Neither do we look at who God uses to heal. **"The Lord is high above all nations; His Glory above the heavens. Who is like the Lord our God, who dwells on high, who humbles Himself to behold the things that are in the heavens and in the earth?"**

God is entirely unlike anyone else we will ever encounter. No one compares to Him. It is not the power of the Church. It is Him.

God is always near His children in their needs. He does not let them face their problems alone. His children need an encounter with Him before His word can become “**Rhema**” and before miracles can manifest.

God is looking for a true worshipper. Genuine praises must be wholehearted. A distracted mind and a divided heart are **incapable** of worshipping God as He deserves. God is unlike anyone else we will ever encounter. No one can compare to Him.

God is the **Champion** for His children. Everything He does is for our good. He desires to build us up and to make us free. When God created mankind it was for good. He did not allow Adam to eat of the fruit from one fruit tree because He wants to shelter Adam from evil. Till you have knowledge of evil, you do not know what evil is. He only wants everything good for His creation but Eve was tempted for more knowledge and for more power. She also finds the fruit good to eat.

Eve fell into temptation and her eyes were opened and she realized her nakedness. Adam felt the same thing. Nakedness means judgement in biblical interpretation. Judgement came upon mankind and Satan. Yet in God’s mercy for every judgement, He brings forth restoration when we repent. As a merciful

and compassionate God, His love for us is beyond our understanding.

In Ex 19:5, He promised to be faithful to His people completely and to bless them above all the peoples of the earth. He spelt out clearly how men should live – to fear Him, to love Him, to obey Him, and to serve Him; keeping all His commandments (Dt 10:12-13) whilst He does His part of blessing us above all the peoples of the earth. As the people obeyed, God promised, “and lo, I am with you always even to the end of the age” (Mt 28:20).

Yet men find it difficult to even observe these simple principles. Each time our spirits get higher to serve Him, the devil comes in with his schemes and we are back to square one – we either give up serving or quit Church. This is not God’s ways.

So my beloved, you need to do your best to observe the above commandments so that it will go well with you. I pray that you will surrender yourselves totally to God and to allow Jesus’ resurrection power to work through you. Let God be your Lord and not your ATM! May you prosper this season not only financially but also mind, soul and spirit as you cycle yourself out of lack this season and enter into a spiritual season of blessings bearing in mind not to allow the ‘**little foxes**’ to spoil your vine. We must move away from our paganistic behaviour.
