WORD FOR THE WEEK

"... and in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice." (Ge 22:18)

Beloved,

I wish all believers a very blessed and joyful Mother's Day.

What is God speaking to us today? According to Scripture above, we as Abraham's seed and all our seeds will be a blessing to all nations because of our obedience. On this Mother's day, God is speaking to us to be godly parents not only for our own children but also our spiritual children.

One cannot exaggerate the importance of godly parents. This is true in the mind and heart of God as seen in the Scriptures and in the life of those God uses mightily, like Samuel. God certainly can and does use anybody but He seems greatly desirous of godly parents to those He would use greatly among His people.

Parents are carefully selected to give birth and to rise before the Lord, those God is purposing to use. This was true of Moses, Samuel and later on John the Baptist and then Jesus. The parents are known to God as faithful and godly before Him. He chose them to have a child and He plans to use them for eternal purposes.

Godly parents are vital. They create a spiritual atmosphere in which a chosen servant of God will be raised and nurtured and remain faithful throughout his life. Parents' godly lifestyles will be one of the greatest influences shaping any servant of God. Timothy was

the product of his godly heritage (2 Ti 1:5).

Elkanah, Samuel's father, is leading his family not merely in worship but in faithful adherence to all the commands of God's Law. His name is associated with faithfulness to God, kindness and tenderness to his wife Hannah. He is a leader in his home and his example affected Samuel, leaving similar character qualities in his young wife and later his walk with God.

Hannah a Godly mother

As Samuel grew up, he heard her mother Hannah praying often with great praise and thanksgiving knowing that he was born in answer to his mother's prayer and his father's support. What a heritage! She was very focused. Her prayer was specific and earnest. She knew what was in her heart and therefore she knew what to pray and was relentless. She would not stop praying until God answered her. Then she made a vow (1 Sam 1:11). God knew her heart and responded through Eli who watched her pray.

Hannah believed God in her heart and everything has now changed. In 1 Sam 1:18, she went away believing that she had received God's answer and she was about to obtain it. The Lord remembered her and she was given a child called Samuel. The word 'Samuel' means 'Heard by God'.

Samuel has observed that Hannah her mother, gave God only the best. Nothing less was acceptable to God. She wanted to be the kind of mother that could receive a son from the Lord and give him back to God with character qualities God would use for Himself. So she had to be

the kind of mother whose character qualities would later be a model for her son. She developed a deep relationship with God. Whatever the Lord brought into her way, she accepted with gladness. This was a deep seated character quality in her life and she passed it on to Samuel.

She drew her daily strength from the Lord. Furthermore, God granted her request. Our children must see God in us. God is able to make all Grace abound to you (2 Cor 9:8). To Hannah, the wisdom and knowledge of God were totally sufficient for her life. She acknowledged this to God in her prayer and to the people around her. As she prayed with confidence in God, Samuel would hear and develop his own trust in the knowledge of God that he would use in his tumultuous life. Samuel never let his understanding come before God's knowledge in any situation. He knew what was in the mind and heart of God. Samuel learned much from his father and mother – their character and quality prayers. These two were enough to make Samuel steadfast before God.

Hannah never knew that with her simplicity in prayer and character, she was instrumental to change the world through her son Samuel whom God used to bring about such a victory for His people and a great fear of the Lord and Israel by the surrounding nations.

Will your son be the "Samuel" God will use to raise in these end days? Be a militant prophetic intercessor today!
